Subject Matter

<u>Reading:</u>

This week targeted sequencing events, drawing conclusions, and identifying cause and effect with our story Officer Buckle and Gloria. Next week we will review target reading strategies and also learn about Martin Luther King Jr.'s life and contributions to our country.

<u>Grammar/Writing:</u>

We will continue to target identifying and using pronouns to replace nouns.

Spelling:

Math:
